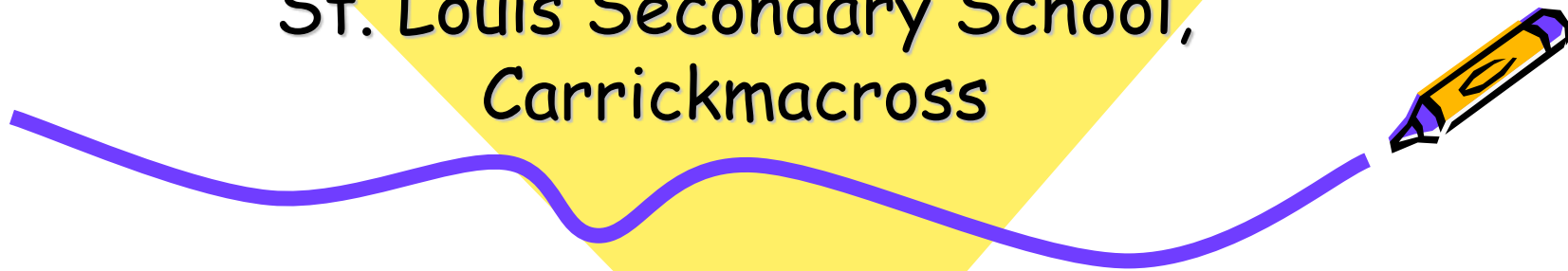


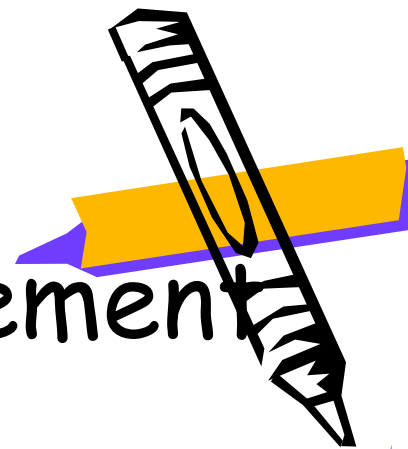

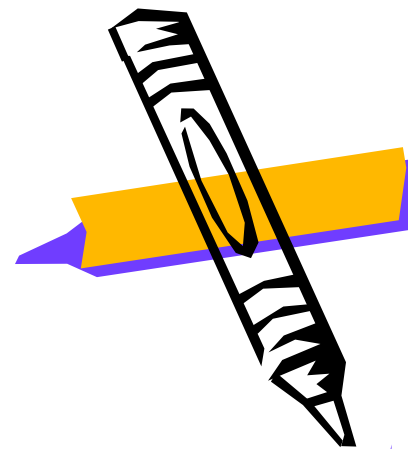
St. Louis SEN Mission Statement

The Learning Support Department

- Work closely with all other subject Departments.
- September 2017 - Introduction of the New Model for allocating additional teaching support for students with SEN.
- With this new model the school will have greater control over sharing the additional resource time evenly among students who are in need of it.
- All subject teachers are informed of the individual needs of the student.



How a student is selected for additional support

- Assessment results of incoming first years
- Psychological Assessment results
- Information supplied by parents/pupils/primary schools
- Recommendations by subject teachers and school exam results.



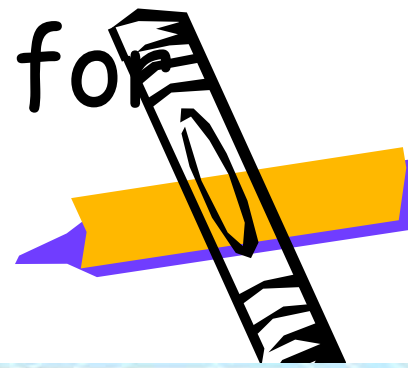
How additional support is offered

- Students view the extra support in a very positive way and students can benefit greatly from it.



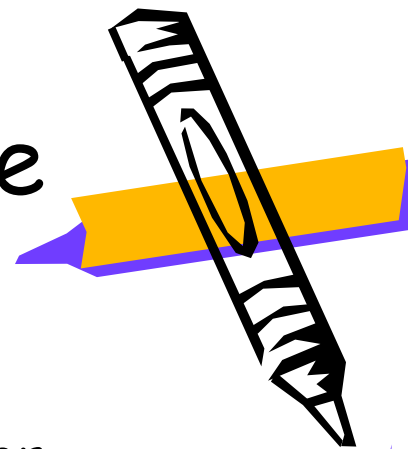
Facilities/Resources available for students with SEN

New ASD Special Class



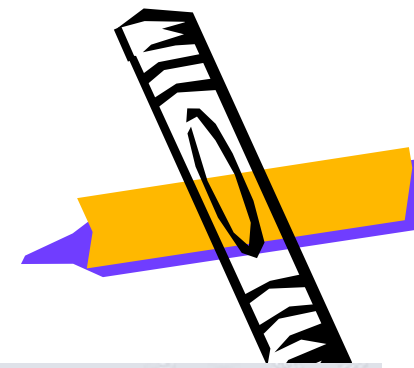
Facilities/Resources available for students with SEN.
